The file *RM_13612_members_roles_-_display_group_of_role_RM_V1.2.1.diff* is a patch for *vendor/plugins/redmine_smile/app/views/projects/settings/_members.rhtml*.

Is it a patch for Redmine core? It looks like a patch for some plugin.

As far as I can tell it's a patch to the core's */projects/settings/_members.rhtml* partial inside a Redmine plugin (*redmine_smile*), thus overloading the core's partial with the modified one. With that in mind I created a patch file against current trunk ([r16111](#)) which I hereby attach. Please note that I haven't tested any of this code, it's just a copy-paste of the patch in note 7 (which at maximum is against [r4719](#)) against current trunk. I quickly scanned the code and think that it should be working at current Redmine codebase though.
