Hi, forks,

I suppose that relative links to icon images in 'public/help/wiki\_syntax.html' should be '../images/jstoolbar/bt\_strong.png', not '../../images/jstoolbar/bt\_strong.png'.

If Redmine is deployed on such as mongrel or webrick, there seems to be no problem, because the links traverse to the root directory so that the absolute paths are converted to '/images/jstoolbar/bt\_strong.png'.

However, the links are broken when I have deployed Redmine to a sub URI on Phusion Passenger (mod\_rails) with Apache configuration 'RailsBaseURI /redmine'.
