CREATE LOGIN redmine WITH PASSWORD = 'my_password', CHECK_EXPIRATION = OFF, CHECK_POLICY = OFF, DEFAULT_DATABA
SE = redmine;
GO
USE redmine;
GO
```

```
CREATE USER redmine FOR LOGIN redmine;  
GO  
EXEC sp_addrolemember 'db_owner', 'redmine';  
GO
```
