<p>When using the REST API to update the versions (using the xml format), the custom fields are ignored if the syntax is used as described on http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/Rest_api</p> <p>After modifying the app/model/version.rb similar to r9783 it worked. The solution is therefore pretty simple.</p> <p>I only checked to update the versions. Maybe this bug is also present for other models.</p>
