<b>Description</b>  In systems where auto-register is disabled, it is somewhat nasty to generate a random password for every new user - especially if a bunch of new users is to be set up. It is already enough work to enter names and email addresses.  I would prefer to have some choice to autogenerate a random password with acceptable complexity (maybe configured by Admin). This could be reached with a simple button "Generate random pwd" beneath the password fields in the new user form and some JavaScript that does the generation (no need to implement this on the "server side").
