Description <p>I was wondering why the accesskey="e" was not working on /issues/:id and discovered that the issue_description textarea already registers the accesskey="e" shortcut.</p> <p>In my case (Chromium 28), the shortcut ends up disabled (it neither clicks 'Update' nor focus on the textarea).</p> <p>Two possible issues :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• rename the ticket update shortcut, maybe as accesskey="u"• remove the textarea accesskey="e" which is actually useless in ticket edition mode
