<p>A custom field (checkbox) exists that is used in multiple projects. A custom query to look for all issues (cross-project) with the checked custom field should be performed. However, it seems that custom field filters do not work cross-project, unless the custom field is marked to be active for all projects.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Create a custom field and make it available in multiple projects. Check "Used as a filter".</li><li>2. Create a custom query</li><li>3. Try to add the custom field to the query.
