I've found no reference only about this particular problem, besides that there is 1 site which also displays this particular way for me. Do note that this does not happen on any windows browser that is viewing the login portal: the problem is exclusively Linux and the way Linux browsers (Chrome/Firefox) probably "tell" which language they are using. Obviously (since displayed correctly under Windows) there is nothing wrong with the translation files.
