<b>Description</b> <p>The process that creates the .tar.gz file is broken. For some reason the archive is missing the execute permissions for the following files:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• public/dispatch.cgi.example</li><li>• public/dispatch.fcgi.example</li><li>• public/dispatch.rb.example</li><li>• script/about</li><li>• script/breakpointer</li><li>• script/console</li><li>• script/destroy</li><li>• script/generate</li><li>• performance/benchmarkmarker</li><li>• performance/profiler</li><li>• script/plugin</li><li>• script/process/reaper</li><li>• script/process/spawner</li><li>• script/process/spinner</li><li>• script/runner</li><li>• script/server</li></ul> <p>I spot checked several archives (0.4.2, 0.6.4, 0.7.3) and none of them had the proper bits set for these files. It should be a fairly simple and low risk fix.</p>
