<b>Description</b>			
this is a regression in 3.0.0 from 2.6.x:			
when creating new issues via REST API (specifically, I am using Redmine Java API library), I see the standard JSon payload I used with Redmine 2.6.x is not accepted anymore:			
<pre>{"issue": {"subject":"test for custom multi fields - set multiple values", "project_id":369, "start_date":null, "custom_field_values":{"3":["V1","V3"]} } }</pre>			
the server ignores values V1, V3 and assigns default V2 value to that multi-line custom field.
