### **Description**

To reproduce:

- 1. Create a task A
- 2. Creata another task B and set A as parent: B -> A
- 3. Create a third task C and set B as parent C -> B -> A

Suppose B and C were both supposed to be children of A:

- 1. Edit C, change the parent field to refer to A instead of B
- 2. Save fails.
- 3. Edit C, change the parent field to nothing.
- 4. Save succeeds
- 5. Edit C, change the parent field to A
- 6. Save succeeds

So it is only possible to make C a child of A by first removing it from B. There seems to be no justification for this?
