<b>Description</b> It seems from <a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineReceivingEmails">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineReceivingEmails</a> and from my tests and reading of redmine code (I do not know anything about ruby) that it's not possible to force the creation of issues from mail handlers (rake redmine:email:receive_imap) to be private by default.  This is sounds like a major feature missing to really use mail handling as an user may not always read before sending a mail that can contain private or sensitive information that should not be made public by default.
