**Description**

The position\_name attribute of IssuePriority instances is currently only recalculated when the position of the IssuePriority instance changes [source:/tags/3.2.0/app/models/issue\\_priority.rb#L22](source:/tags/3.2.0/app/models/issue_priority.rb#L22)

However, the position\_name should also be recalculated when the active attribute changes.

I would even argue that that operation is quick enough, and that changes to the IssuePriority list are not frequent and done by administrators, so that the recalculation of the position\_name can be done on after\_save without filtering.
