Description

When clicking the new Import link in the side bar menu of Issues, the project information seems to be lost.

There are several consequences:

1. Clicking the sidebar links in one of the import steps has various consequences, from no action (custom queries) to Error 500 (Calendar, Gantt)
2. When reaching the field mapping step, there is a project which is preselected, but not the one the import link was clicked from.
