<p>The new code highlighting toolbar button (#14937 / r15316) is providing support for all the CodeRay-supported languages except the 'taskpaper' language. While the CodeRay support for it can be questioned, I think it's best to keep the languages provided by the button in sync with the languages supported natively by CodeRay (as is the Redmine core documentation after r14489).</p> <p>This issue is limited to simply adding the language name 'taskpaper' to the codeRayLanguages array in source:trunk/public/javascripts/jstoolbar/jstoolbar.js (I'm ignoring the minification steps here).</p> <p>Thanks in advance.</p>
