<p>I have been developing several plugins for our Redmine, and hooks are a really good mechanism overall, but I have been struggling with the way they are partially implemented or even missing in some views / controllers.</p> <p>It would be nice to have hooks implemented for all forms / controllers, equally.</p> <p>Let me give some examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• IssuesController has hooks for the Create action, but not for the Update action• IssueStatuses form partial has a call_hook, but it does not add the form itself (f) as a param, which makes it impossible to add additional elements to the form itself. The related IssueStatusesController does not have hooks for the Create or Update action• There are hooks for the Users form, and the form is passed as a param, which is nice, but there is no hook at all in the UsersController (Create, Update...)
