Hi, in our company we commonly link from Redmine issues to documents on our Lotus Notes servers. These links look like this:

"Notes":Notes:///4125749A0018C13D/42FC5416F4D71EB04925749E0021CF19/A5352E3CC7379C3B49159538003D1A6

or this:

"Notes":Notes://homeserver/4125749A0018C13D/42FC5416F4D71EB04925749E0021CF19/A5352E3CC7379C3B49159538003D1A6B

That worked very well till revision <u>r2212</u>. Afterward, due to the stricter checking, the text was shown as entered, not rendered as hyperlink anymore.

Attached patch re-enables support for rendering of Lotus Notes links.

I would appreciate if you could apply the patch (or let me know your concerns if not).
