<p>As the subject states, the file download button is also displayed on repository directory entries. This obviously shouldn't be the case. This issue has been introduced with r16672 for #26035.</p> <p>I'll attach a small patch fixing the issue. I've included the addition of a test assertion (for Git) showcasing the issue.
