<p>When calling Datepicker an array of objects was passed incorrectly: at the time of the call <code>\$(input).datepickerFallback("option", "defaultDate", default_date);</code> [application.js:689] in array is passed 3 arguments, but in [application.js:216-217] one argument is passed to the function. Function is declared <code>\$.fn.datepickerFallback = function( options )</code> [application.js:836] with one argument. Therefore when calling the "real" Datepicker only one argument is passed instead of three.</p> <p>The attached patch fixes this.</p>
