**Description**

Journal overrides save method from ActiveRecord::Base like that

```
def save
  ...
end
```

while it should be

```
def save(perform_validation = true)
  ...
end
```

or

```
def save(*args)
  ...
end
```

With current definition, any call passing an argument to the save method - Journal#update\_attribute for example - will raise an exception like this one:

```
