Description

The change [r17678](#) moved some action links on a wiki page to the drop-down menu. Lock/Unlock button was moved as well.

Due to the change, you cannot know whether the wiki page is locked without clicking the drop-down menu. The buttons also have a function to show the locked/unlocked status of a page. I think the change made usability worse because Lock/Unlock status of a wiki page is one of the important information.

I propose the change to making the Lock/Unlock icon visible again.

I think it is a nicer solution than I suggested. Actually, my solution is not useful for ordinary users because the lock/unlock button is visible for only privileged users. Currently, they cannot know the reason why the wiki page is not editable. The problem is reported as [#9634](#).
