Description

It'd be nice if Redmine's issue filters included some notion of issue relations. That way you could build a query like so:

- Status is open
- Assigned to me
- Start is less than 0 days ago
- **Has no blocking issues**
- **Has no preceding issues**

Doesn't look trivial, but shouldn't be too difficult. Looking into it now...
