<b>Description</b>			
<p>When reading RSS feed in MS Outlook, inline links are broken due to the partial URL without host address. I tested it with other RSS readers, such as IE 7.0, FireFox 3.0.10 and Google Reader, but no problems are there. However, MS Outlook can't parse the link properly.</p> <p>We can fix this problem by modifying the line 27 of /trunk/app/views/common/feed.atom.rxml as shown in the followings.</p> <pre>xml.text! textilizable(item.event_description, :only_path =&gt; false)</pre> <p>Please, include the above in the next version.</p> <p>Thanks.</p>
