<p>When i hosted redMine to my remote server, all is fine but when I'm trying to run redMine on my local machine, the login form is not behaving as it should: in fact when substituting the form opening way from:</p> <pre><%= form_tag({:action => "login"}, :class => "tabular")%></pre> <p>to</p> <pre><% form_tag({:action=> "login"}, :class => "tabular") do %></pre> <p>it was shown correctly.</p> <p>Maybe it's caused by the rails version, I'm running with:</p> <p>Ruby 1.8.5-21 Rails to 1.1.6</p>
