<b>Description</b> <p>When editing long wiki pages, text "disappears" from the end of the document. This seems to be caused by the fact that Redmine uses datatype "text" (at least in MySQL) to store wiki page contents. Pages exceeding 65535 characters are truncated.</p> <p>This should probably be changed to MEDIUMTEXT or LONGTEXT or similar, or the system should as a minimum give the user a warning (right now, submissions of changes to a wiki page are accepted and text is simply silently discarded from the end of the document).</p>
