<b>Description</b> <p>Whenever you edit property for a bunch of tasks (let say, you change their priority or target version), Redmine sends a single mail notification to registered people for EVERY task, by providing the same information. For me, it makes much more sense to send a unique email, saying: "the property X has been modified to Y for the following tasks: <a href="#">#1</a>, <a href="#">#2</a>, <a href="#">#3</a>."</p> <p>This need is evident, for example, when you start a project with no versions, then you create a version and assign all the past tasks to this version.
