<b>Description</b> Recently we have started using redmine to track the software projects and we are planning to implement it for the non-software projects also. However, on evaluation an the following permission issue is blocking our implementation.  Project members(with role Developers) can log time on any of the issues irrespective of the <b>Assigned To</b> field. This may create chaos when using redmine in a non-software environment, where members may not be technically proficient.  Issues should be viewable to everyone in the project, but members should not be allowed to track time on issues assigned to others.
