| <b>Description</b> <p>This is an extension of <a href="#">#3614</a>, which only dealt with making exported columns in PDF documents match the output of a custom issue query. That issue was closed with the changes in <a href="#">r2841</a>.</p> <p>I blatantly plagiarized the code in <a href="#">r2841</a> to make the necessary code changes to the issues_helper to see if I could get CSV exports to similarly export the user-specified fields in a custom issue query. It works well for me, but I'm not familiar enough with either Ruby or Redmine itself to definitely say it's a good patch.
