<p>I'm using Redmine trunk, and recently updated to <a href="#">r3603</a>.</p> <p>Now I am seeing some incorrect behavior in the text formatting. I don't remember if it was doing this before too, but I think it only started happening after the update.</p> <p>A sentence containing with double dashes used as em-dashes is appearing with strikethrough on the portion in-between.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>This is an example sentence -- this part should not be crossed out -- how will it look?</p> <p>On my system looks like this: This is an example sentence <del>this part should not be crossed out</del> how will it look?</p> <p>It does not seem to be happening here. Interesting! Here it's rendering like this: This is an example sentence -- this part should not be crossed out -- how will it look?</p>
