<b>Description</b> Currently Redmine provides a 'preview' feature when creating an issue for the first time or creating a new note on an issue. It would be nice if the user could also preview changes to the texts of issue descriptions and notes.  At the moment the only option is to commit a change and see what it looks like, then edit it again, which can cause a lot of email notifications to be sent out.
