However the issue count below the completion bar is correct. And when I click '0.1' to get a separate page of all the tickets of only that particular version, the ticket is included in the list correctly.

Note: the steps above are for the sake of brevity. I actually did not create just two empty projects, I have several projects with many tickets each and wanted to try the shared versions feature.
