Apparently cascading update/delete is active for tasks plus their subtasks.  That's probably not intended - especially due to the fact that the application doesn't state that fact anywhere (e.g. dialog upon deletion). Also the views don't suggest such a "tight" binding of subtasks to their according parent-tasks.
