<p>When writing a comment, I can insert a link to a file in the repository with e.g. <code>source:trunk/app/controllers/issues_controller.rb</code>; I can also insert a link to a specific revision's root, e.g. <code>r4020</code>.</p> <p>However, if I would like to insert a link to a specific version of a file, I have to write the full URL, e.g. <a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/repository/revisions/4020/entry/trunk/app/controllers/issues_controller.rb">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/repository/revisions/4020/entry/trunk/app/controllers/issues_controller.rb</a> , or, at least a local one, like "Issues controller @ rev 4020" : <code>/projects/redmine/repository/revisions/4020/entry/trunk/app/controllers/issues_controller.rb</code>.</p> <p>Instead, we could use e.g.</p> <pre>source:/trunk/app/controllers/issues_controller.rb@4020</pre>
