<b>Description</b> I want to view the utf-8 text file in repository, but it is downloaded.  In RepositoriesController#entry(), String#is_binary_data? is used to determine the file is binary or not. But String#is_binary_data? return true even if the file is utf-8 text.  I wrote a patch to fix this problem.

I confirmed [source:trunk/config/locales/ja.yml](#) is as binary.  
[repositories\\_controller.patch](#) is only for UTF-8.  
Redmine supports multi encoding.  
For example, ISO-8859-1, Japanese Shift\_JIS, EUC-JP...  
Iconv passes converting from ISO-8859-1 to UTF-8 with no error.

I will fix [#6256](#) in another way.
