<p>Not sure if this should be a feature or patch?</p> <p>I setup redmine to be used as a service database for customer issue tracking. I would like to be able to use a project name for multiple instances. This would allow me to setup a customer, then have a subproject for each piece of equipment they have. I could then use the serial number of that product as the unique identifier.</p> <p>Ex: Customer1 - product1 - product2 Customer2 - product1 - product2</p> <p>Currently i can only use a project name once, so i have to do something like this</p> <p>Customer1 - product1_c1 - product2_c1 Customer2 - product1_c2 - product2_c2</p> <p>It's just a bit of a pain, and does not look as clean as i would like while listing the projects.</p> <p>If anyone has any suggestions on an alternate way to do this that would be great!</p> <p>Thanks for any help.
