<p>In the reports section I don't seem to be able to get any data into the "open" and "closed" columns, even though I have both opened and closed issues. Seems kinda weird since "total" should be "open" + "closed", right?</p> <p>When I press the magnifying glass for one of the tables I see correct counters, except I also have a status "open" and "closed" (in addition to "Closed", "New", etc...) which both show zero. These ones also have no color box next to them.</p> <p>See screenshot.</p>

I've tracked it down to the "closed" => 0 in views/reports/_simple.rhtml and similar files.

In postgresql you need "closed" => "t" for true. I'm not sure what you need for false. "f" wasn't it.

Sorry. It was "f". Unrelated typo.

Do you want a patch for this? I'm not sure how you want to differentiate database engines, and just changing "closed" => 0 to "closed" => "f" will probably break mysql support.
