**Description**

I just tried to show a calendar with a custom query, so something like: [http://my.redmi.ne/issues/calendar?query\\_id=13](http://my.redmi.ne/issues/calendar?query_id=13), which causes redmine to quit on a:

The solution is to include SortHelper in CalendarsController.
