<p>The "label fixed" version for tickets suggests that the field is used to indicate, in which version the ticket <i>was</i> fixed whereas the correct meaning seems to be the version the ticket is targeted to be fixed. Naming it "Target version" would be better imho.</p> <p>(It's even more confusing in the german translation.)</p>
