<b>Description</b> Redmine should be provide some handling of "mid-air collision" as in Bugzilla. Bugzilla does not lock records. It provides mid-air collision detection, and offers the offending user a choice of options to deal with the conflict: exit without push changes and push changes anyway.  For me this is a defect because cause dataloss, but I add it to tracker feature
