From forum posts: v1.2.0 throws 302 http responses and then enters a 404 page 404 Error when adding posts, issues, wiki edits			
Essentially, after adding submitting a POST request Redmine returns a 404 even though the URL is valid, and the POST data was submitted successfully.
