Scenario:  User leaves company. All their issues that are open and ones that were closed in last 2 weeks need to be reassigned with a custom status. As administrator I try to change status and I am told I don't have permissions. Now I have to add myself to project, only to change status, and then remove myself from project. And I have to do that many times from many different projects.	
Solutions:  For Redmine administrators allow all actions, give warning if they do something that is outside of typical use (like changing status outside of typical workflow).
