There is bug in displaying issues: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I'm in project, for example: redmine.ourdomain.com/projects/myproject/</li><li>• I go to issues: redmine.ourdomain.com/projects/myproject/issues</li><li>• Then I select my custom query (global one, not public) by clicking on custom query name in right column (My open issues)</li><li>• Now I go to another page in same project, like homepage of project: redmine.ourdomain.com/projects/myproject/</li><li>• Now when I go back to Issues page by clicking on menu tab, I'm on right place: <a href="http://red.idn.cz/projects/pepsi-football2008/issues">http://red.idn.cz/projects/pepsi-football2008/issues</a> but I see my tickets for all projects, not for current project only.</li><li>• When I click on name of custom query in the right column, everything is ok again. It seems there is some problem that redmine "remembers" my last view of Issues page, but interprets it in a wrong way.</li></ul>
