Description

I updated to [r1352](#) (though the issue was in [r1341](#) as well) and now batch edits do not appear to work at all.

Using the new method, I select several issues to edit and then right-click->Edit. I get the Bulk Edit window with one issue listed at the top of the page and only that issue is changed by the edit.

I tried this in Safari 3.1 and Firefox 3b4 on Mac OS X.
