Description

Hi.

I'm trying to install redmine 1.3.2 on Ubuntu 12.04 LTS
mysql Ver 14.14 Distrib 5.5.22, for debian-linux-gnu (x86_64) using readline 6.2
ruby 1.8.7 (2011-06-30 patchlevel 352) [x86_64-linux]
Rails 2.3.14
gem 1.8.15

I've been trying to do it via apt-get install redmine redmine-mysql

But I still get a rake error on the db:migrate phase.

Here are what I get when trying to launch the install via :
