Description			
<p>In older version(s) of Redmine (1.2 in our case) rubygems is implicitly loaded by one of the other support libraries required at the start of the script.</p> <p>In 1.4.2 these libraries have changed and implicit loading of rubygems has gone leading to a LoadError on "require 'activeresource'". Adding a "require 'rubygems'" before this code solves the issue.</p>
