Description

This ticket requests a single feature:

- Update the "add watcher" interface on issues to allow the addition of non-members of a project as watchers on an issue.

This has been asked for and partially addressed several times in the past:

- [#3448](#) - Never addressed. This issue is still open, but it is a slightly different request regarding the scalability of the "add watcher" interface for extremely large numbers of users.
- [#5159](#) - The solution to this ticket allowed users to **add themselves** as a watcher if they weren't a member, but it didn't allow other people to add them.
- [#6065](#) - This ticket re-iterated the problem with the solution to [#5159](#) -- "[add additional users] without having to send them an email asking them to go to this ticket and press *watch" -- but it was dismissed as a duplicate of [#6226](#).
- [#6226](#) - The patch submitted for this ticket supposedly solved the issue, but doesn't look to have been included in the trunk. It was subsequently closed as a duplicate of [#5159](#).
- [#9942](#) - This asked for 3 features. 2 of the features were already implemented in [#5159](#). The third feature is similar to the request for this issue. This was closed as a duplicate of [#5159](#).
