Description			
Trying to filter issues for negative custom field integers (and possibly other integers) doesn't work due to the regex under the "when :integer" clause in validate_query_filters in <a href="#">source:trunk/app/models/query.rb</a> , which doesn't allow a leading sign.			
I have it in 1.4.3, but I see that the issue is in trunk also, on line 177. I fixed it in my version by replacing the regex with:			
/ <sup>^</sup> [+-]?\\d+\$/
