Wouldn't it be easier to show there actual comment connected to revision which I entered which is "testowy commit3" in this case or at least link to URL/projects/PROJECT_NAME/repository/revisions/2568 ?

In my opinion would be both - comment I entered (not an automatic one) + link to revision.
