# **Description**

We enabled the log file rotation by changing *config/additional\_environment.rb* like this:

```
#Logger.new(PATH,NUM_FILES_TO_ROTATE,FILE_SIZE)
config.logger = Logger.new(config.log_path, 7, 1000000)
config.logger.level = Logger::INFO
```

After a restart of Redmine, we get this error message: undefined method `log\_path' for #<Rails::Application::Configuration:0xb60966d4>
