We enabled the log file rotation by changing <i>config/additional_environment.rb</i> like this:			
<pre>#Logger.new(PATH, NUM_FILES_TO_ROTATE, FILE_SIZE) config.logger = Logger.new(config.log_path, 7, 1000000) config.logger.level = Logger::INFO</pre>			
After a restart of Redmine, we get this error message: <i>undefined method `log_path' for #<Rails::Application::Configuration:0xb60966d4></i>
